



School Crossing Supervisor Expression of Interest

About the role

- School Crossing Supervisors (SCS) must be available to work both morning **and** afternoon shifts (on the same day) in all weather conditions
- Crossing times vary at each school, with shifts up to one hour in the morning and half an hour in the afternoon (school terms only)
- Rostered shifts will vary at each school
- Additional ad hoc work opportunities may be offered
- Generous casual pay rate
- The minimum age for employment as a SCS is 18 years of age.

Commencement of employment for the successful applicant is dependent on:

- The favourable outcome of a pre-employment health assessment
- A Positive Notice Blue Card (you **do not** need to have a blue card to apply for the position)

Please note: The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) pays for both the Health Assessment and the Blue Card.
